EDUCATION OPTIONS IN THE UNITED STATES

High School Education or GED/HiSET	Students in grades 9-12 are taught more complicated ideas in all subjects as well as move to greater independence as learners. GED or HiSET is a test you take on Math, English, History and Science to prove you have knowledge equal to a US High School Diploma.
College	The most common term used to talk about where you get your education after you finish high school.
Technical School	Teaches skills used by individuals in certain jobs such as a car mechanic, computer hardware repairman, restaurant chef, heat and air conditioning repairman. Technical schools provide a hands-on environment that prepares you to work in these types of jobs.
Community College (MSJC) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Employment Concentrations, Certificates, Associate of Arts (AA) or Associate of Science (AS) degrees 	Provides 2-year degrees in certain areas of study like technical schools. Many community colleges prepare you to transfer to a 4 year college or university for further study.
University <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science degrees • Master Degrees • PhD's 	Is usually considered different from a college because of the many different levels of education that you can complete.
