


Q4 Please indicate whether you expect the MSJC Libraries to be the primary resource for supporting your students' assignments or research papers.







Q5 How often do you give assignments that require your students to use library resources?





Q6 Which library resources and services do you direct your students to use? Check all that apply.








Q9 Do you bring your students in for library orientations or have you scheduled a custom orientation in your classroom?
