- To <u>evaluate college performance</u> on the state's educational priorities
- To provide colleges and districts with <u>information</u>
 <u>to help improve</u> their programs








Progress and Achievement Rate




2. Students Who Earned at Least 30 Units

while in the CCC system (1st time students)




Students Who Earned at Least 30 Units




3. **Persistence** Rate

% 1st time students with a minimum of 6 units earned in a Fall term and who returned and enrolled in the subsequent Fall term anywhere in the system




Persistence Rate




4. Annual Successful Course Completion Rate for Credit <u>Vocational</u> Courses

excluding k-12 students




Vocational Completion Rate




5. Annual <u>Successful</u> Course Completion for Credit <u>Basic Skills</u> Courses

Annual Successful Course <u>Completion</u> for Credit <u>Basic Skills</u> Courses





% of students enrolled in credit ESL courses who successfully completed that initial course




ESL Improvement Rates Relative to CCC Colleges




7. Basic Skills Improvement Rate


Students who successfully completed an English or Math basic skill course & successfully completed a higher level course in the same discipline within 3 AY
