

- 6. <u>Improvement</u> Rates for <u>ESL</u> courses
- 7. <u>Improvement</u> Rates for Credit <u>Basic Skills</u> courses

 - to our **peer group**


#1. Progress and Achievement Rate






#2.1st Time Students Who Earned at Least 30 Units

while in the CCC system




#2.1st Time Students Who Earned at Least 30 Units Relative to Peer Group




#3. Persistence Rate

% 1st time students with a minimum of 6 units earned in a Fall term and who returned and enrolled in the subsequent Fall term anywhere in the system








#4. Annual Successful Course Completion Rate for Credit Vocational Courses



#4. Vocational Completion Rate Relative to Peer Group




#5. Annual <u>Successful</u> Course Completion for Credit <u>Basic Skills</u> Courses






#6. ESL Improvement Rate

% of students <u>enrolled in credit ESL courses who successfully completed</u> that <u>initial course</u>




#6. ESL Improvement Rate Relative to Peer Group




#7. Basic Skills Improvement Rate


Students who successfully completed an English or math basic skill course & successfully completed a higher level course in the same discipline within 3 AYs

MSJC ARCC 2012 Report Recap 5 out of 7 Accountability Indicators <u>Increased</u> vs. 2011 Report



MSJC... improvement in 5 of the 7 indicators

- Student progress & achievement rate
- Percent of students who earned 30 units
- annual successful course completion rate for vocational courses
- Credit basic skills completion
- ESL Improvement Rates
- Due primarily to the expansion of <u>student success initiatives</u> three years ago coupled with a major emphasis on professional development among faculty.
- <u>Interventions</u> made a difference.
 - Supplemental Instruction (SI)
 - Learning Communities
 - First Year Experience
 - Strategies and interventions rooted in the college's STEM grant
 - o The ESL program indicator is trending up due to much focused planning in this area.
- The <u>persistence rate</u> did not show improvement after hitting 67% in 2008-2009 and declining to 64%.
 - o This will become an action item for improvement with the instruction and student service divisions.
- Despite the challenge of the state budget reductions, MSJC is making every effort to minimize the impact of these constraints on student access and success.
