Promising Practices & Special Focus

What are students telling us about the way our institution functions?

▶ Promising Practices

- ▶ Registration – students lack some access to courses they need for completion
- ▶ Orientation - Students don't know what to do or where to go to be successful at MSJC
- ▶ Connection experiences / success programs – most MSJC students do not participate in these programs

▶ Special Focus

- ▶ Diverse perspectives – students are exposed to and try to understand perspectives different than their own
- ▶ Barriers to success – Financial concerns are the biggest factor to students. Course access is the next largest factor
- ▶ Location – MVC is the preferred campus for our current student body
- ▶ Facilities – The appearance of campus facilities, buildings, and grounds do matter to students
- ▶ Equity – Students feel that they are treated fairly.

Promising Practices

What are students telling us about the way our institution functions?

- ▶ Students need better orientation services than what we provide.
 - ▶ 20% participated in an on campus orientation.
 - ▶ 55% participated in an online orientation
 - ▶ 49% indicated they were satisfaction with orientation services.
- ▶ Students need to participate in more programs that connect them to the college community and orient them for success at MSJC
 - ▶ 84% did not participate in a first year experience
 - ▶ 88% did not participate in an LCOM
 - ▶ 91% did not participate in a student success course
