New Enrollment Policy for Adult Education Starting Fall 24

All students must attend an in-person registration appointment to enroll in classes.

Starting the Fall 24 semester, all adult education students will be required to attend a registration appointment to enroll in an ESL, Citizenship, or GED class.

Students will fill out an application, take a test for recommended level placement, register for classes, and receive an orientation.

Registration sessions will be offered in-person at the Temecula Valley, Menifee Valley, and San Jacinto Campuses.

Morning and evening sessions will be offered.

- Morning: 8:00 am 1:00 pm
- Evening: 4:00 pm 8:00 pm

Registration appointments will become available the first week of June. Check our website at msjc.edu/adulted to sign up for an appointment. Please plan on staying the duration of the appointment.

*Please note, all students must attend a registration appointment to enroll in our program.

*Due to program testing, no children are able to attend the appointment.

What to Expect at Registration Appointment

- **Step 1:** Sign up online to attend registration appointment at a campus nearest to you.
- **Step 2:** New Students: Fill out Adult Education application.

 Returning Students: Update Adult Education application information.
- Step 3: Take CASAS test for recommended level placement.
 - *ESL/Citizenship students will take a reading and listening test.
 - *Citizenship students will take a government test.
 - *GED students will take a math and English test.
- Step 4: Enroll in classes based on your CASAS level.
- **Step 5:** Attend an orientation to learn about program requirements, procedures, and available resources for students.

FREE English as a Second Language (ESL), Citizenship (CITZ), High School Education Classes (GED), and Introduction to Career Classes

English as a Second Language (ESL)

Our ESL classes help you develop listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills that pertain to life and work in the United States.

Adult Basic Education (ABE)

Our ABE classes prepare you for basic mathematics, reading, and writing to prepare you for GED level classes.

General Education Development (GED)

Our GED classes prepare you to take the GED or HiSET exam that, when passed, offers a high school equivalency certificate.

Citizenship (CITZ)

Citizenship classes prepare immigrants for the naturalization process and the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services interview. You will learn U.S. government and history and practice reading and speaking skills necessary to pass the test.

Introduction to Career Classes

Introduction to Career Classes are non-credit classes that help prepare you to jumpstart your career or re-enter the workforce. Students will learn new skills within these career pathways which lead to employment opportunities. These introductory career courses also support students wishing to continue their education within certificate or degree programs at Mt. San Jacinto College.
