Watercolor Supply List

- 1) Reds : Alizarin Crimson, Cadmium Red
- 2) Blues: Cobalt Blue, Cerulian Blue, Ultramarine Blue
- 3) Browns: Burnt Umber, Burnt Sienna
- 4) Green: Sap Green
- 5) Yellow: Lemon, Azo Yellow, Cadmium Yellow (any one of these).

Brushes:

- 1" flat
- 1/2" flat
- #12 round
- #3 or #4 round

Supplies:

- Palette or a plastic plate
- Jar for Water
- #4H pencil
- Eraser
- Kleenex
- Rag to Wipe Brushes
- Sponge
- Salt
- Masking Liquid
- Masking Tape
- Plywood or heavy cardboard to mount paper (12" x 16")

Instructor uses 260 lb. single elephant paper - Arche's Cold Pressed Watercolor paper – 25 3/4" x 40"

(Students can do 8 paintings on one sheet).

Instructor can give you a sheet each for \$10.00 or 1/8 sheet for \$1.25.
