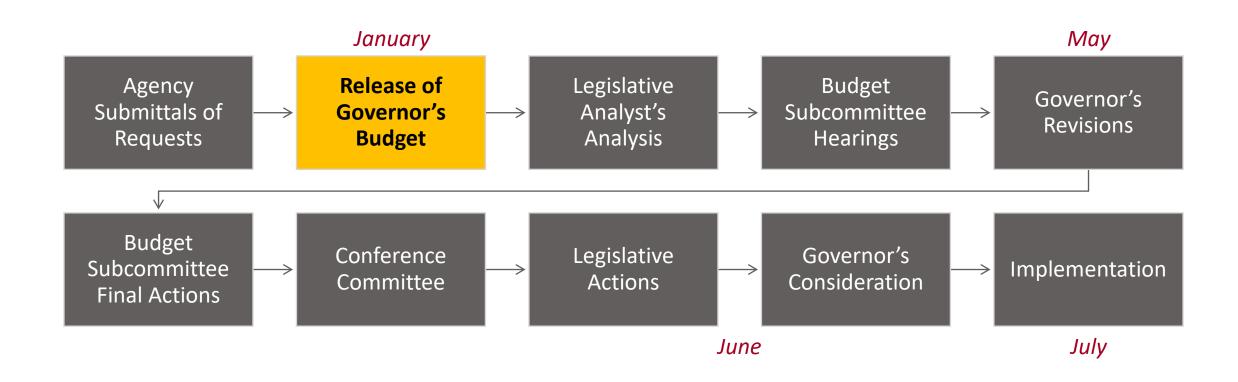

2024-25 Proposed Budget Priorities

- Maintain fiscal stability
- Continue efforts to address priority issues, such as:
 - Homelessness
 - Combatting effects of climate change
 - Avoid harmful cuts in programs essential to the well-being of Californians

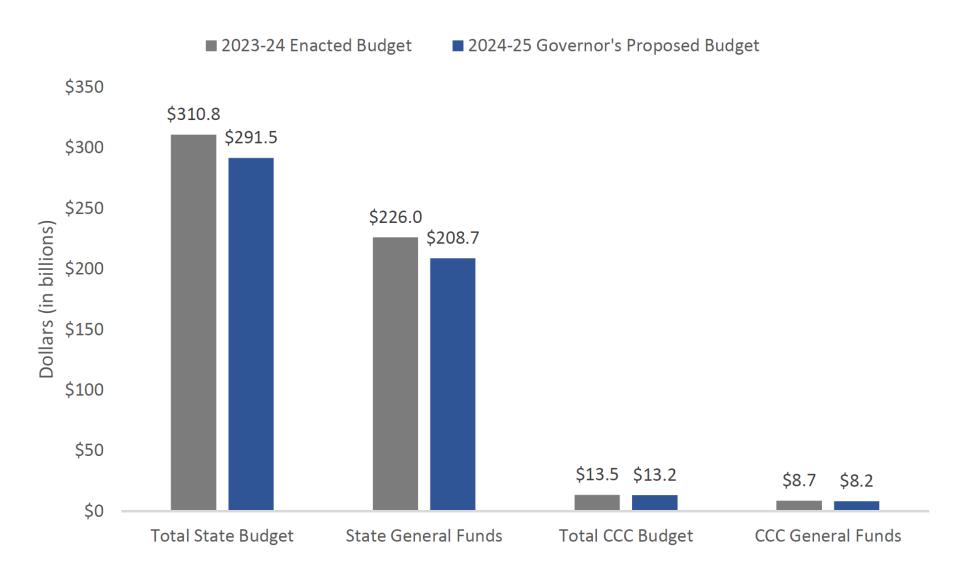
2024-25 Proposed Budget Features

- Identifies developments over last two (2) years generating budget shortfall facing lawmakers:
 - Substantial decline in the stock market that drove down revenues in 2022
 - Unprecedented delay in critical income tax collections
- Projected \$37.9B budget gap
 - Reserves (\$13.1B)
 - Reductions (\$8.5B)
 - Revenue/Internal Borrowing (\$5.7B)
 - Delays (\$5.1B)
 - Fund Shifts (\$3.4B)
 - Deferrals (\$2.1B)

2024-25 Proposed Budget Features

- Notes improved conditions:
 - Stock market rose throughout 2023 making up most losses from 2022
 - California's GDP remained strong in 2023
- Identifies potential risk factors that could negatively impact ongoing economic & revenue growth:
 - Significant shock from tightening financial conditions
 - Stock market and asset price volatility and declines
 - Geopolitical turmoil

CCC Student Centered Funding Formula (SCFF)

Statewide SCFF, \$9,463.13M

- **0.76% COLA**, \$69.15M
- **0.5% Growth**, \$29.59M
- \$486.2M of SCFF costs (approx. 5.14%) for 2024-25 covered by one-time reserve funds
- \$235.9M in *one-time* reserve funds added for 2023-24 to offset low revenues bringing total *one-time* funding for 2023-24 SCFF funding to \$525.9M

CCC Other Statewide Policy Adjustments

Ongoing Investments:

- 0.76% COLA for Adult Ed., EOPS, DSPS, CalWORKS, Mandates Block Grant, Apprenticeship,
 CARE, & Childcare Tax Bailout
- **\$0.65M** increase Mandates Block Grant & Reimbursements
- \$50.0M increase to Student Success Completion Grant
- \$1.53M increase to Financial Aid Administration

One-time Investments:

\$60.0M to expand nursing program capacity
