

The combination of a dedicated and capable coaching staff, state-of-the-art facilities, and an unrivaled Student-Athlete Support Program has allowed the department to assist students in earning over \$1 million in scholarships to colleges and universities across the country.

MSJC has a strong legacy of athletic excellence, with numerous postseason appearances, multiple conference championships, and a 2018 state title in women's basketball. Many Eagles have advanced to compete at four-year institutions. Among MSJC's notable alums is former NBA first-round draft pick Jamaal Tinsley.

Beyond the game, MSJC prioritizes student-athlete success through its comprehensive Student-Athlete Support Program, offering academic and personal development resources. These include a dedicated Student-Athlete Study Center, Scholars Program, Tutoring Services, and Progress Reports.

Student-athletes also benefit from the Summer Bridge Program and the Annual Athletic Forum, designed to enhance their academic and athletic journeys. With a commitment to excellence on and off the field, MSJC fosters an environment where student-athletes thrive, preparing them for competition, academics, and beyond.



At MSJC, students can access enriching opportunities beyond the traditional two-year college experience. Student Life is vibrant, featuring a variety of clubs and monthly events such as student BBQs, homecoming celebrations, and more.

The Student Government Association (SGA) serves as the student body's voice, advocating for student rights and fostering awareness of key issues. SGA also promotes academic, cultural, social, and community engagement. Meanwhile, The Talon, MSJC's student-run news outlet, informs students of on-campus events and important topics.

MSJC offers the Honors Enrichment Program for those seeking academic enrichment and is home to a 5-star chapter of Phi Theta Kappa, the prestigious international honor society. Leadership development is also a priority, with programs like the Puente Project, Umoja Community, A2MEND, and dedicated leadership courses designed to empower students and support their educational goals.

Online Learning

- Online Real-Time classes with required, scheduled, live online meetings to provide simultaneous interaction with the instructor and other students in real-time.
- Online Anytime classes are available on your own time, 24/7 via Canvas. Interaction with the instructor and other students may take place through discussion boards, group assignments, email, and other means. While instructors may offer optional Zoom sessions, real-time meetings are not required.
- Blended Courses offer a combination of Online Real-Time and Online Anytime components. There will be required, scheduled, live online meetings and more flexible instruction available on your own time.
- **Hybrid Courses** are a combination of face-to-face and online. Courses such as nursing and automotive require some face-to-face meetings, for example.



MSJC can help prepare you for high-wage, high-skill jobs in demand. Top professors teach our courses in real-world environments and are equipped with current, industry-specific technology, tools, equipment, and curriculum. - ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE: The Administration of Justice and Corrections program prepares students to earn a certificate, associate degree, or associate degree for transfer to a four-year university. The program is designed to prepare students for entry into various careers within the criminal justice field at the federal, state, county, or municipal levels. This includes police officers, deputy sheriffs, probation/parole officers, or corrections officers. Courses involve working with the latest equipment and technology: use of force and driving simulators, 3D laser crime scene and collision reconstruction scanners, forensics equipment, and computerized composite sketching software.
- AUTOMOTIVE TECHNOLOGY: The Automotive Technology program at MSJC emphasizes
 a real-world approach to diagnostic skill building and a thorough understanding of system
 theory and operations. This is accomplished using computer programs, audiovisual aids,
 instructor-led demonstrations, and hands-on experiences, such as state-of-the-art
 simulators, mock-ups, and modern vehicles.
- AVIATION SCIENCE: Aviation Science prepares students to become professional pilots or flight operations specialists. The program can be tailored to meet the needs of individual students and is designed for students without any flying experience.
- BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION: MSJC's Business Administration program offers various degree and certificate pathways, including an associate degree, associate degree for transfer, and certificates.



- COMPUTER SCIENCE INFORMATION SYSTEMS/CYBER SECURITY: CSIS offers students a well-equipped technical environment for instruction and lab. All CSIS courses are taught in computer-equipped classrooms, allowing hands-on experience using industry-standard hardware, application software, operating systems, networking, and programming tools. In addition to the CSIS degree, MSJC offers focused, specialized areas of study in networking, Internet authoring, programming, and others.
- CREATIVE MEDIA: Creative Media students learn hands-on, industry-ready skills in video
 production, visual effects, audio, photography, web design, or social media marketing to get started
 in the expanding digital media field. Students have access to cutting-edge equipment, with courses
 in both classrooms and professional live-streaming studios.
- GEOSPATIAL INFORMATION SCIENCE (GIS)/DRONE: GIS provides students a framework for gathering, managing, and analyzing data. GIS analyzes spatial location and organizes layers of information into visualizations using different kinds of map images and incorporating 2D and 3D scenes.
- NURSING AND ALLIED HEALTH: MSJC offers many career options in the health field. Some require one or two semesters, such as emergency medical technician (EMT). Others, including diagnostic medical sonography (DMS), take four semesters. Within the Nursing and Allied Health program, the career-ladder approach to education enables students to set short/or long-term attainable goals. MSJC's Nursing program continues to rank among the top programs in the state and nation, with consistently higher National Council Licensing Exam pass rates than most schools, ranging between 95% and 100%. The job market for Registered Nurses is forecast to grow nationwide, and nursing graduates secure employment in our region.



- WINE INDUSTRY AND HOSPITALITY: Wine Industry and Hospitality will prepare you for an exciting career in the wine industry. Our program introduces you to various disciplines in the winemaking industry. From basic winemaking (enology), grape cultivation (viticulture), event organization, and service (hospitality) to marketing and selling of wine (business principles). Mt. San Jacinto College's Wine Industry and Hospitality program will introduce you to the wine industry's many fields.
- DIAGNOSTIC MEDICAL SONOGRAPHY: The Diagnostic Medical Sonography (DMS) program at Mt. San Jacinto College is a competitive, non-transfer Associate of Science degree designed to prepare students for a rewarding healthcare career. Spanning four semesters plus one summer term, the program includes a 12-month clinical internship where students gain hands-on experience under licensed sonographers. In state-of-the-art campus labs and affiliated medical centers, students master ultrasound techniques and develop critical anatomy, pathology, patient care, and communication skills. Graduates are equipped to perform various ultrasound exams, including abdominal, obstetric, gynecological, and vascular studies, and are prepared to sit for national ARDMS exams such as Sonography Physics and Instrumentation (SPI), Abdominal (ABD), and Obstetrics and Gynecology (OB-GYN).

MSJC transfers more than 1,000 students annually to UC, CSU, and private universities. MSJC is proud of its history of students who achieve top honors in higher education, such as the Jack Kent Cooke Scholarships, Gates Millennium Scholars, Coca-Cola Academic Team Scholars, and more.

The Associate Degree for Transfer (A.A.-T or A.S.-T) or ADT guarantees that students will meet the minimum eligibility requirements of the California State University (CSU) system. Students earning an ADT will be admitted to a CSU (not necessarily to a particular campus or major). You may be granted a bump in your GPA when applying to an impacted campus outside your local area or an impacted major deemed similar.

If you are admitted and enrolled in a designated similar degree program, you can complete your bachelor's degree with as little as 60 semester or 90 quarter units of coursework. A counselor will help you determine which CSUs offer bachelor's degrees that correspond to your ADT. It is still important for you to apply to the schools that interest you and follow admissions deadlines to be considered.

TAG agreements may also guarantee admission to some University of California (UC) system colleges upon completing a contract between the student and a four-year representative from the respective university. Agreements do not guarantee admission to the major of your choice.

Enrollment Checklist

Step 1 ADMISSIONS: Complete an online admissions application and follow the steps at *msjc.edu/apply*

Step 2 FINANCIAL AID: Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at *studentaid.gov*

Step 3

ORIENTATION: Complete the online Orientation that is designed to introduce students to the policies, procedures, and services offered at MSJC.

Step 4 COUNSELING: Counselors can assist students in academic, career, and personal counseling. You can schedule an appointment with a counselor during your first semester to finish your path to success.

Step 5

REGISTRATION: Students register for courses online, on or after their assigned registration date and time (emailed after completion of online orientation). Pay all registration fees at time of registration.
