Mt. San Jacinto College Foundation "Help a Student" Grant Application and Guidelines

The Mt. San Jacinto College Foundation exists for the purpose of providing support to the faculty, staff and students of MSJC. In addition to student scholarships, the "Help a Student" Grant is one way the Foundation provides support for students that are not eligible for funding from traditional resources. Funds for this grant are provided by MSJC students that make a donation to the "Help a Student Fund" with additional support from the MSJC Foundation.

What are Help a Student Grants?

The grant is an institutional program to allow students that are not eligible for Financial Aid and/or EOPS to apply for funds to cover books and supplies, institutional charges and fees up to \$250.00.

*Students that qualify for Financial Aid and/or EOPS are receiving financial assistance that can be utilized to cover educational costs beyond tuition fees and are therefore ineligible for this grant

What are the Submission Guidelines?

Applications will be reviewed and awarded on a first come first serve basis, during the application timeline or until funds have been exhausted each term. Applications must be received by the Foundation office during the application timeline. No late applications will be accepted.

Students may only receive one grant per Academic Year:

• Applications for the Spring 2020 semester will be accepted from Monday, January 6th thru Friday, January 17th or until funding has been exhausted.

All applications must be received by <u>noon (12:00pm)</u> on the last day of the application period.

Who can apply for a Help a Student Grant?

- Any student that is experiencing financial hardship
- Does Not qualify for Financial Aid or is Only receiving a fee waiver
- Does Not qualify for EOPS
- Is in good academic standing
- Currently enrolled 3/4 Time (9 units or more)
- Has not already received a "Help a Student" grant for the academic 2019/2020 year

How do I Apply?

Complete the entire grant application, providing all required information within the application timeline. **Applications are to be submitted to the Foundation Office via email at MSJCFoundation@msjc.edu**. Applications will not be accepted in person and may not be submitted to another department.

The Foundation will work with Financial Aid to complete the "Financial Aid" portion of the application. This process generally takes 1 to 2 working days and then your application will be reviewed by the Foundation.

Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.
