

IF FEDERAL IMMIGRATION OFFICERS ARE ON CAMPUS

What to do

In the event that a federal immigration official is present on campus and seeks access to student information, district records, or entry into a facility, please remember the following:

1 Stay Calm & Composed

It is important to remain calm and composed in this situation. Kindly inform the official that our college has specific procedures that we must adhere to. Remember, you are not obligated to take any action on behalf of the official.

2 Request for Identification

Politely ask the official to provide their name, ID number, and agency for verification purposes. If they are unwilling to share this information, feel free to request another officer to be present along with a college official.

3 Understand Your Rights

It is crucial to be aware of your rights in such situations. Remember, you have the right to remain silent and are not legally obligated to speak, answer, or respond to any enforcement official. Only comply if they present a judicial warrant.
