



GENERAL STUDIES CORE TRANSFER PLAN To Azusa Pacific University College from Mt. San Jacinto College

This transfer plan is to be used as a guide for undergraduate students wishing to transfer to Azusa Pacific University College (UC). Completion is *not* required for admission to UC. This is not an articulation agreement but a tool to aid students in knowing which courses UC will accept to fulfill General Studies requirements. It is the student’s responsibility to see that all of the requirements are met upon completing their degree at UC.

Note: Some departments include specific General Studies courses as part of the major requirements. Please check with the current Azusa Pacific University College catalog for your major’s current requirements. Additionally, honors level courses are equally as acceptable to fulfill degree requirements as their non-honors counterparts.

IGETC/CSU GE

UC accepts the completed IGETC or CSU GE as fulfilling the Azusa Pacific University College General Studies Core program requirements. In addition to their completed IGETC or CSU/GE, the student will also need to complete six (6) hours of Biblical Studies.

In the cases of both the CSU GE and IGETC, the certificate must be complete, and the certificate must be obtained from the respective community college before the student matriculates to UC. Students who do not receive certification of completion will be evaluated by standard course-to-course articulation and will follow the UC General Studies Core program.

UC Transfer Reminders:

- The university can give credit for no more than 70 units of community college work, and there is a maximum of 90 units that may be accepted from a four-year institution.
- No course from a community college can transfer to meet an UC upper-division requirement.
- Any course may still be transferable for non-general education elective units *if* designated as CSU/UC transferable in the course catalog.
- Only courses where a grade of C- or above has been earned can be considered for transfer credit.
- A minimum grade-point average of 2.0 (academic GPA) for all college work completed is required for admission to UC.
- There is no minimum unit requirement for admission to UC.
