**BA in Criminal Justice transfer reminders:**

- APU accepts fully completed **IGETC** and **CSU GE Certifications** (partial certifications will not be honored).
- The university can give credit for no more than 70 units from a two-year college or a maximum of 90 units from a four-year institution. 30 transferable units are required for admission into the BA in Criminal Justice program.
- No course from a two-year or junior college can transfer to meet an APU upper division requirement.
- Any course may still be transferable for non-general studies elective units *if* designated as CSU/UC transferable in the course catalog.
- A minimum C (2.0) grade-point average is required for all transferable college work completed for admission to APU.
- A total of 48 units are required for the major. A minimum 2.0 grade-point average is required in all major courses, including the specified General Education classes. Students must pass all required courses with a C or higher.
- Please see the Grad and Professional catalog for additional information regarding admissions as a transfer student.
